Solera Friends and Family Real Estate Donation Program

If you or anyone you know is thinking of buying, selling, or refinancing a home, you could help our Center earn \$1,500 to \$2,500. Rosanna de Leon and Bill Soady own and operate Solera Real Estate, and they are long-term members of the Beaumont Center for Spiritual Living. They created this donation program to help us raise money for our Center.

Here are the basic details on the donation program that Rosanna and Bill are extending to our Center:

Someone at the Center needs to inform Rosanna or Bill that they have someone that wants to get information on a reverse mortgage or real estate transaction.

Rosanna or Bill meets with the prospect and hopefully secures a reverse mortgage application or real estate contract.

When the mortgage or transaction closes escrow, Solera donates (from escrow) \$1,500 for a conventional loan, \$2,000 for a real estate transaction, or \$2,500 for a reverse mortgage.
